Your challenge is to **research about a famous Ancient Egypt Pharaoh**.

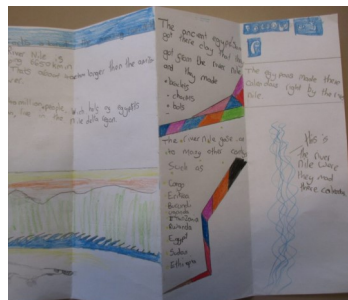
You could choose: Cleopatra, Tutankhamun, Khufu or any others that you may find.

The Pyramids of Ancient Egypt	
<p>Why were the pyramids built? The pyramids were built for the pharaohs of Egypt as their tombs. When they died, their mummified bodies were placed in a room in the pyramids to keep the body safe.</p>	
<p>Where are the pyramids? The pyramids were built on the west bank of the River Nile in Egypt. Some of the most famous pyramids are found at Giza.</p>	
<p>How were the pyramids built? The pyramids were built using large blocks of sandstone. These heavy stones were transported by boat. No one is sure how the pyramids were built but most people believe that a ramp was used to put the sandstone into position.</p>	
<p>What are the Great Pyramids? The Great Pyramids are three pyramids in Giza which are guarded by the sphinx. The biggest of these pyramids is the only one of the 7 Great Wonders of the World left. It took 20 years to build and is 146 m tall. It was built for pharaoh Khufu.</p>	
<p>What are pyramids like inside? Pyramids usually have corridors leading to several different rooms. Doors were often hidden so tomb robbers wouldn't be able to find the pharaoh's mummy or treasure. Pyramids are usually decorated inside with tomb paintings which tell us details about what life in ancient Egypt was like.</p>
