About the book...

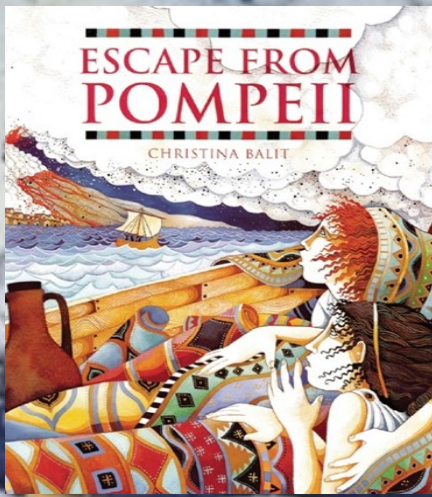
