Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens. • Pay attention to more than one thing at a time, which can be difficult. • Use a wider range of vocabulary. • Understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as: 'Get your coat and wait at the door'. • Understand 'why' questions, like: 'Why do you think the caterpillar got fat?' • Sing a large repertoire of songs. • Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story. • Develop their communication but may continue to have problems with irregular tenses and plurals, such as 'runned' for 'ran' or 'swimmed' for 'swam'. • Develop their pronunciation but may have problems saying some sounds (such as r, j, th, ch, sh) or multisyllabic words (such as pterodactyl, planetarium or hippopotamus). • Use longer sentences of four to six words. • Be able to express a point of view and to debate when they disagree with an adult or a friend, using words as well as actions. • Start a conversation with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns. • Use talk to organise themselves and their play.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors. • Use a comfortable grip with good control when holding pens and pencils. • Show a preference for a dominant hand.
Literacy	<p>Understand the five key concepts about print:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ print has meaning ○ print can have different purposes ○ we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom ○ the names of the different parts of a book ○ page sequencing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can spot and suggest rhymes • Count or clap syllables in a word • Recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother • Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary. • Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; writing 'm' for mummy. • Write some letters accurately
