#### **People We Know**

#### **Visits and Visitors**

We will visit the local area investigating familiar Places. We will have visitors from around school, emergency services and the hedgehog rescue centre.

#### **Understanding the World**

This term we will be finding out all about our family and local area. We will find out about emergency services, Harvest time and how we are all different

#### **Communication and Language**

Over the term, we will learn how to communicate with each other using new vocabulary
