This school Easter holiday, at Hull Museums, we will be running a selection of free fun activity sessions for children living in Hull, aged 5-16 years as part of the Healthy Holidays Hull programme with either a healthy packed lunch (for the prebooked sessions) or a healthy snack (for the drop-in sessions) provided for each child who attends.
