Plants and Animals

Visits and Visitors

This term we will visit Sewerby Zoo and seaside, looking at the animals, especially the penguins and taking a trip on the Land Train for a picnic on the beach.

Understanding the World

This term we will be finding out all about plants and what they need to grow, exploring the natural world around us.

Communication and Language

Over the term, we will learn how to communicate with each other by asking questions and listening to stories and understanding what has been read.

Physical Development

This term we will develop our confidence and precision with a ball together with talking about how we can maintain good health.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term, we will look at the natural world and create pictures using paint and collage. We will be studying different artists too!

Mathematics

This term, we will be sorting objects and numbers to 20. Learning how to add and subtract amounts together with writing number sentences.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be learning about our families and how they are different. Talking about mutual respect.

Literacy

We will be learning how to use the sounds we know to write words and simple sentences. We will be expanding our vocabulary and learning to spell using Fred Fingers

Outdoor Learning

This term we will look at how things grow, looking at plants and animals including insects. We will be planting beans and other seeds in our outdoor area and taking good care of them as we watch them grow. We will learn how to respect and care for all living things and the environments in which they live. We will investigate different environments and explore the effects of heat and drought in parts of the world. But most of all we will have lots of fun together in the outdoors!
