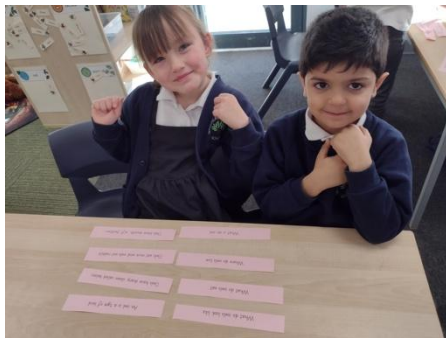


## Year 1 Hedgehogs – Mrs Phillips
