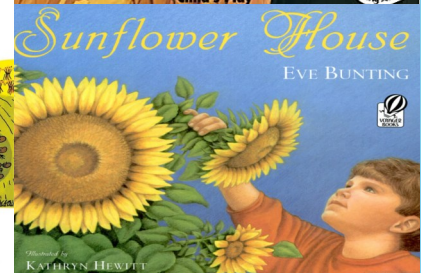
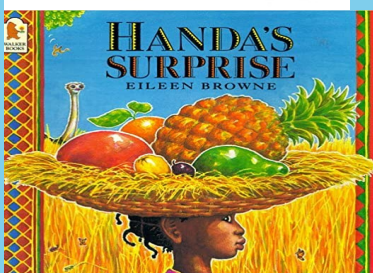
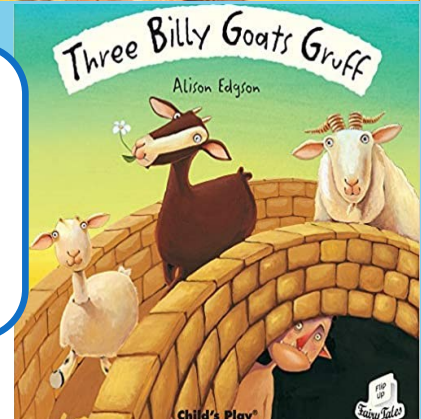
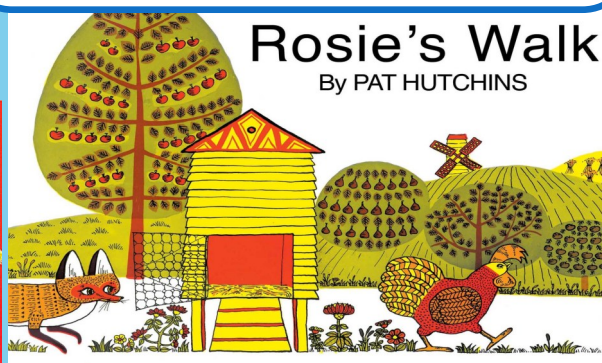


Woodland Primary School EYFS Newsletter Summer 2025

Our learning this half term will be focussed on...

In FS1, forming some or all of the letters in my name.

In FS2, beginning to write simple captions and sentences.

In FS1, beginning to hold a continued conversation during informal play.

In FS2, joining sentences together using 'and' or 'because'.

In FS1, we are beginning to understand and answer 'why' questions.

In FS2, we are asking questions to find out more about **everything!**

During Summer we will be planting seeds and looking after the allotment. We will be hatching our own chicks and visiting a farm

In FS1, we are beginning to hear words with the same initial sound

'I spy with my little eye...'
In FS2, we are beginning to read words and sentences.

In FS1, linking numerals and amounts, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral. (up to 5).

In FS2 we are beginning to explore how numbers can be made up (6 can be 4 and 2 or 3 and 3 etc)

In EYFS we will be talking about growth, animal babies and the life cycle of a chicken and a Runner Bean.

In FS1, we will be exploring creative ideas and deciding on which materials to use.

In FS2, we will be developing and refining our ideas .
