Our learning this half term will be focussed on...

Learning to read and write our name (F\$1)

Understanding how many objects we have counted (F\$1) and understanding the relationship of numbers in (F\$2)

Exploring our natural world (cold places), starting with a 'Winter walk'

Learning about our planet Earth and where we live. Who helps us?

Exploring colour mixing, including powder paints and adding white to see what happens.

Joining different materials together and exploring different textures. Making 3d buildings.

Learning that there are different countries in the world who have different celebrations
