Our learning this term will be focussed on...

Learning to read and write our name, draw pictures and share stories and books in FS1

Learning to blend sounds and letters to read and write captions and sentences (FS2).

Understanding how many objects we have counted (FS1) and counting to 20, counting in two's and using money . FS2)

Exploring our natural world (life cycles, starting with a 'Frogspawn', then hatching some chicks.

Looking at plants, sowing seeds and learning to look after them and all living things in the environment.

Exploring patterns using natural resources such as flower heads, petals and sticks. Learning to draw the different parts.

We will look at different vehicles from now and from the past.

Learning that there are different countries in the world and how would we travel to get there.
